A bill to be entitled

An act relating to prohibiting the registration of firearms; amending s. 790.001, F.S.; defining the term "computer-aided dispatch (CAD) system"; amending s. 790.335, F.S.; exempting from the prohibition of keeping records of firearms records generated by a computer-assisted dispatch system used for officer safety; providing an effective date.

Be It Enacted by the Legislature of the State of Florida:

Section 1. Subsection (20) is added to section 790.001, Florida Statutes, to read:

790.001 Definitions.--As used in this chapter, except where the context otherwise requires:

(20) "Computer-aided dispatch (CAD) system" means an electronic database system that provides the public safety call-taker and dispatcher with a ready resource of call information, unit availability, and other factors.

Section 2. Paragraph (s) is added to subsection (3) of section 790.335, Florida Statutes, to read:

790.335 Prohibition of registration of firearms.--

(3) EXCEPTIONS.--The provisions of this section shall not apply to:

(s) Computer-aided dispatch (CAD) systems used for officer safety.

Section 3. This act shall take effect July 1, 2005.
