The Committee on Judiciary (Webster) recommended the following amendment:

Senate Amendment

On page 8, between lines 4 and 5,

insert:

(32) "Substantial occupational exposure" means employment for an extended period of time in industries and occupations in which, for a substantial portion of a normal work year for that occupation, the exposed person did any of the following:

(a) Handled raw asbestos fibers;

(b) Fabricated asbestos-containing products so that the person was exposed to raw asbestos fibers in the fabrication process;

(c) Altered, repaired, or otherwise worked with an asbestos-containing product in a manner that exposed the person on a regular basis to asbestos fibers; or

(d) Worked in close proximity to other persons engaged in any of the activities described in paragraphs (a)-(c) in a
