Senator Saunders moved the following amendment:

**Senate Amendment (with title amendment)**

On page 2, lines 1-15, delete those lines

and insert:

(2) Notwithstanding any law to the contrary, in order to maintain a class action seeking monetary relief, the class must allege and prove actual or statutory damages. In any such class action, the monetary recovery shall be limited to the amount of actual and statutory damages. Nothing in this section shall be construed to limit or restrict the ability of the Attorney General to bring a class action for the recovery of statutory penalties, if otherwise authorized by law. However, class action claimants may seek to obtain, if appropriate, nonmonetary relief, including injunctive relief and orders, declaratory relief and orders or judgments enjoining wrongful conduct, or equitable relief, regardless of whether the class action claimants can prove any actual monetary damages. Nothing in this section shall be construed to in any way limit or restrict the availability of such
