On page 1, line 16,

insert:

Section 1. Subsection (21) is added to section 768.28,  
Florida Statutes, to read:

768.28 Waiver of sovereign immunity in tort actions;  
recovery limits; limitation on attorney fees; statute of  
limitations; exclusions; indemnification; risk management  
programs.--

(21) If the state, for itself or an agency or  
subdivision, waives sovereign immunity and settles a claim  
against it or such agency or subdivision, a claims bill need  
not be filed with the Legislature if funds are available to  
pay the claim.
