2	A resolution recognizing April 2005 as "Cancer
3	Control Awareness Month."

5	WHEREAS, cancer will strike approximately one out of
6	two men and about one out of every three women in the course
7	of their lives, and
8	WHEREAS, cancer accounts for one out of every four
9	deaths, and is the leading cause of death, and
10	WHEREAS, the American Cancer Society estimates that
11	more than 96,200 new cases of cancer in Florida will be
12	diagnosed and more than 39,960 Floridians will die from cancer
13	during the year 2005, and
14	WHEREAS, many cancers can be prevented by lifestyle
15	changes, or cured if detected early and treated promptly, and
16	WHEREAS, as many as one-third of the cancer deaths
17	expected in Florida this year will be related to nutrition,
18	physical inactivity, obesity, and other lifestyle factors, and
19	thus may have been prevented, and
20	WHEREAS, almost half of all Floridians who continue to
21	smoke may expect to die prematurely from lung cancer or other
22	tobacco-related diseases, and
23	WHEREAS, 30 percent of all cancer deaths and 87 percent
24	of all lung cancer deaths are caused by smoking cigarettes or
25	other tobacco products, and
26	WHEREAS, the 5-year survival rate for all cancers
27	combined is 64 percent, but survival rates may increase
28	significantly for certain cancers such as breast, cervical,
29	and colorectal cancers when they are detected and treated
30	early, and

WHEREAS, rates of cancer incidence and death in Florida 2 may be significantly reduced with increased awareness of the 3 American Cancer Society's cancer-screening guidelines and 4 compliance with those screening guidelines, and 5 WHEREAS, promotion of Cancer Control Awareness Month and statewide cancer control initiatives, such as the Florida Dialogue on Cancer sponsored by the American Cancer Society, may assist Florida in significantly reducing the burden of 8 cancer faced by Floridians and the state, NOW, THEREFORE, 9 10 11 Be It Resolved by the Senate of the State of Florida: 12 That the month of April 2005 is recognized as "Cancer 13 Control Awareness Month" in Florida and all Floridians are 14 urged to understand the risks associated with cancer, change 15 behaviors that increase their cancer risks, and follow the 16 American Cancer Society's cancer-screening guidelines. 18 19 20 21 22 23 2.4 25 26 27 28 29 30 31
