| 11 | Section 1. Paper Reduction Task Force                           |
| 12 | (1) The Paper Reduction Task Force shall be established         |
| 13 | for the purpose of recommending strategies to reduce the        |
| 14 | paperwork required of school districts and school district      |
| 15 | personnel, with special emphasis given to the reduction of      |
| 16 | paperwork required of teachers. Recommendations shall include,  |
| 17 | but not be limited to, methods to improve efficiency by         |
| 18 | eliminating, reducing, revising, or consolidating paperwork and |
| 19 | data collection requirements. The task force shall recommend    |
| 20 | methods to minimize the paperwork burden being placed on school |
| 21 | districts and school district personnel by evaluating the need  |
| 22 | for information and determining whether access to necessary     |
| 23 | information is already available.                               |
| 24 | (2) The task force shall consist of the Commissioner of         |
