A bill to be entitled

An act relating to citrus canker eradication;
repealing s. 4 of ch. 2002-11, Laws of Florida;
abrogating the repeal of s. 581.184(1)(b),
F.S., which defines the term "exposed to
infection" for purposes for eradicating citrus
canker disease; providing an effective date.

Be It Enacted by the Legislature of the State of Florida:

Section 1. Section 4 of chapter 2002-11, Laws of
Florida, is repealed.

Section 2. This act shall take effect upon becoming a
law.

SENATE SUMMARY

Abrogates the repeal, scheduled for July 1, 2005, of a
definition describing citrus trees that are exposed to
infection from citrus canker bacteria.
