Section 403.891, Florida Statutes, is 14 created to read: 15 403.891 Water Protection and Sustainability Program 16 17 Trust Fund of the Department of Environmental Protection .--(1) The Water Protection and Sustainability Program 18 Trust Fund is created within the Department of Environmental 19 Protection. The purpose of the trust fund is to receive funds 2.0 21 pursuant to s. 201.15(1)(d)2., funds from other sources provided for in law and the General Appropriations Act, and 22 23 funds received by the department in order to implement the provisions of the Water Sustainability and Protection Program 2.4 created in s. 403.890. 25 (2) Notwithstanding s. 216.301 and pursuant to s. 26 27 216.351, any balance in the trust fund at the end of any 2.8 fiscal year shall remain in the trust fund at the end of the year and shall be available for carrying out the purposes of 29 30 the trust fund. 31

(3) Pursuant to s. 19(f)(2), Art. III of the State Constitution, the trust fund shall, unless terminated sooner, be terminated on July 1, 2009. Prior to its scheduled termination, the trust fund shall be reviewed as provided in <u>s. 215.3206(1) and (2).</u> Section 2. This act shall take effect July 1, 2005, if CS for CS for CS for Senate Bill 444 or similar legislation is adopted in the same legislative session or an extension thereof and becomes law. STATEMENT OF SUBSTANTIAL CHANGES CONTAINED IN COMMITTEE SUBSTITUTE FOR CS Senate Bill 332 The committee substitute removes the reference to bonding, and allows the department to deposit federal grants and other funds into the Water Sustainability and Protection Trust Fund. 

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
