18	WHEREAS, Officer George Varon, a police officer
19	employed by the City of Miami Beach Police Department, while
20	in the course and scope of his duties as a City of Miami Beach
21	police officer, drove a Miami Beach police vehicle on the soft
22	sand of Miami Beach and negligently drove through an area of
23	sunbathers near a lifeguard station, and in fact did drive
24	over Stephanie and Sandrine Tunc with his police vehicle,
25	proximately causing the death of Stephanie Tunc and serious
26	permanent injuries to Sandrine Tunc, and
27	WHEREAS, Stephanie Tunc was crushed to death by the
28	vehicle and died shortly after the incident, and Sandrine Tunc
29	survived the accident and was transferred to the Ryder Trauma
30	Center at the Jackson Memorial Hospital, and

1 WHEREAS, the parents of Stephanie Tunc, Claude Tunc and 2 Martine Tunc, seek to recover damages for their mental pain and suffering, as well as future loss of support of services 3 based on the death of their daughter, and 4 5 WHEREAS, Sandrine Tunc seeks damages for past pain and 6 suffering, disability, impairment, disfigurement, mental 7 anguish, inconvenience, and lost capacity to enjoy life; 8 future pain, suffering, disability, impairment, disfigurement, mental anguish, inconvenience, and lost capacity to enjoy 9 life; loss of future earning capacity; and future medical and 10 psychiatric care and rehabilitation, and 11 12 WHEREAS, Sandrine Tunc was hospitalized from February 13 22, 2003, through February 28, 2003, at the Jackson Memorial Hospital for a lacerated liver, fractured ribs, punctured 14 lung, contusions, and hematomas, and, as a result of the 15 injuries, has disfiguring scars, as well as a permanent 16 17 hardened cyst-like hematoma in the lower left groin area, and 18 WHEREAS, Sandrine Tunc incurred a medical bill of \$37,624.20 for her treatment at the Jackson Memorial Hospital 19 20 Trauma Center, and the decedent, Stephanie Tunc, incurred a 21 bill of \$45,030.24 at the Jackson Memorial Hospital Trauma 22 Center, and 23 WHEREAS, Sandrine Tunc is receiving continuous medical and psychiatric care due to the above injuries, as well as the 2.4 emotional trauma of watching her sister being crushed to death 25 by the vehicle while they were lying side by side on the 26 27 beach, and 2.8 WHEREAS, as a result of a suit filed following the 29 incident, the City of Miami Beach Commission voluntarily agreed to a settlement of this cause in the amount of \$1.5 30 million, of which \$200,000 will be paid by the City of Miami 31 2

Beach and the remaining \$1.3 million will submitted pursuant 1 2 to a claim bill to be presented to the Legislature in the amount of \$1.3 million which the City of Miami Beach agreed to 3 4 support and approve; the City of Miami Beach Commission did in fact convene and adopt the settlement, thereby agreeing to 5 б support and give its approval to a claim bill to be presented 7 to the Legislature in the amount of \$1.3 million, NOW, THEREFORE, 8 9 10 Be It Enacted by the Legislature of the State of Florida: 11 12 Section 1.
