I. Amendments Contained in Message:

House refused to concur in **Senate amendment 144848**, requests the Senate to recede.

II. Summary of Amendments Contained in Message:

Senate Amendment 144848 inserted the provisions of CS/SB 1866 relating to the Fish and Wildlife Conservation Commission. The amendment changes the membership of the Boating Advisory Council and the terms of office. The amendment also provides that a firm or corporation may only receive a saltwater products license issued to a valid commercial vessel registration number. Provides that the license may not be transferred to another individual, firm, or corporation.

Provides for certain license fees to be increased.

Repeals the provisions relating to environmental education and the Advisory Council on Environmental Education.

These provisions are contained in HB 989, which has passed the Legislature.
