A bill to be entitled  
 An act relating to the Criminal Punishment Code; amending  
 s. 921.0022, F.S.; including offenses involving the  
 possession of photographic material containing sexual  
 conduct by a minor, the transmission of pornography by  
 electronic device, and the transmission to a minor of  
 material harmful to minors by electronic device within the  
 offense severity ranking chart of the Criminal Punishment  
 Code; reclassifying within the offense severity ranking  
 chart the offense of soliciting a child by a computer  
 service to commit an unlawful sexual act, which is a  
 felony of the third degree, to increase the penalty  
 imposed for that offense; providing an effective date.

Be It Enacted by the Legislature of the State of Florida:

Section 1. Paragraphs (e), (f), and (g) of subsection (3)  
 of section 921.0022, Florida Statutes, are amended to read:
