Senate Amendment (with title amendment)

On page 30, between lines 6 and 7,

insert:

Section 11. Paragraph (1) of subsection (2) of section
163.3191, Florida Statutes, is amended to read:

163.3191 Evaluation and appraisal of comprehensive
plan.--

(2) The report shall present an evaluation and
assessment of the comprehensive plan and shall contain
appropriate statements to update the comprehensive plan,
including, but not limited to, words, maps, illustrations, or
other media, related to:

(1) The report must evaluate whether the local
government has been successful in identifying water supply
sources, including conservation and reuse, necessary to meet
existing and projected water use demand for the comprehensive
plan's established planning period. The water supply sources

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1 evaluated in the report must be consistent with evaluation
2 ~~must consider~~ the appropriate water management district's
3 regional water supply plan approved pursuant to s. 373.0361.
4 The report must evaluate the degree to which the local
5 government has implemented the work plan for water supply
6 facilities included in the potable water element. The potable
7 ~~water element must be revised to include a work plan, covering~~
8 ~~at least a 10-year planning period, for building any water~~
9 ~~supply facilities that are identified in the element as~~
10 ~~necessary to serve existing and new development and for which~~
11 ~~the local government is responsible.~~
