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           (c) When a nurse registry contracts to provide
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   services to a patient, the nurse registry shall advise the
   patient, the patient's family, or any other person acting on
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   behalf of the patient that registered nurses are available to
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   visit the patient's home for an additional cost. A registered
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   nurse shall make monthly visits to the patient's home to
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    assess the patient's condition and quality of care being
    provided by the certified nursing assistant or home health
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   aide. Any condition which in the professional judgment of the
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   nurse requires further medical attention shall be reported to
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    the attending physician and the nurse registry. The assessment

    shall become a part of the patient's file with the nurse
   registry and may be reviewed by the agency during their survey
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   procedure.
