



1 of insurance coverage under a commercial liability insurance  
2 policy with limits of at least \$1 million per accident and \$1  
3 million annual aggregate. Evidence of such insurance policy  
4 must be available at all reasonable hours for inspection by  
5 any law enforcement officer.

6 (3) Any person engaged in retrofitting, rebuilding, or  
7 modifying commercial trucks, truck tractors, or heavy trucks,  
8 as defined in s. 320.01, into dump trucks must ensure that the  
9 retrofitted, rebuilt, or modified dump truck complies with all  
10 federal safety standards provided in 49 C.F.R. s. 393.

11 (4) Any person who violates this section commits a  
12 misdemeanor of the second degree, punishable as provided in s.  
13 775.082 or s. 775.083. Any person who violates this section a  
14 second time commits a misdemeanor of the first degree,  
15 punishable as provided in s. 775.082 or s. 775.083. Any person  
16 who violates this section a third or subsequent time commits a  
17 felony of the third degree, punishable as provided in s.  
18 775.082, s. 775.083, or s. 775.084.

19 Section 2. This act shall take effect October 1, 2005.

22 SENATE SUMMARY

23 Requires persons engaged in retrofitting, rebuilding, or  
24 modifying commercial trucks, truck-tractors, or heavy  
25 trucks into dump trucks to have evidence of a commercial  
26 liability insurance policy with minimum limits of \$1  
27 million per accident and \$1 million aggregate.  
28 Establishes safety standards for such trucks. Provides  
29 penalties.
