(1) No later than January 1, 2006, all counties must adopt an ordinance that requires every driver of a motor vehicle that is regularly used for the transportation of students to or from school, or to or from school activities, who receives compensation for such services to register with the county.

- (2) The ordinance shall require, at a minimum, that by January 1, 2006, each driver:
- (a) Must meet level 2 background screening standards as set forth in chapter 435. The county shall submit the fingerprints of each driver to the Department of Law Enforcement for state processing and the Department of Law Enforcement shall forward the fingerprints to the Federal Bureau of Investigation for national processing. The Department of Law Enforcement shall render an invoice to the county for the fingerprints submitted each month. The county shall screen background results to determine if the applicant meets the level 2 background screening standards.
- (b) Must hold a valid commercial driver's license with a passenger endorsement.
- (3) Each driver shall reimburse the county for any costs of background screening or for any other expenses related to administration of the ordinance.
- (4) The provisions of this section shall not apply to drivers employed by a public school or private school who meet the requirements of s. 1012.45 or s. 1002.42.
  - Section 2. This act shall take effect July 1, 2005.
