A bill to be entitled

An act relating to requirements for high school graduation; amending s. 1003.43, F.S.; providing that a student who is unable to earn passing scores on the Florida Comprehensive Assessment Test or its equivalent must be allowed to participate in graduation ceremonies; providing an effective date.

Be It Enacted by the Legislature of the State of Florida:

Section 1. Paragraph (c) is added to subsection (10) of section 1003.43, Florida Statutes, to read:

1003.43 General requirements for high school graduation.--

(10)

(c) A student who completes the minimum number of credits and other requirements prescribed by subsections (1) and (4), but who is unable to meet the standards of paragraph (5)(a), shall be allowed to participate in graduation ceremonies.

Section 2. This act shall take effect upon becoming a law.

SENATE SUMMARY

Provides that a student who is unable to earn passing scores on the Florida Comprehensive Assessment Test or its equivalent must nevertheless be allowed to participate in graduation ceremonies.
