15 (b) To operate a motor vehicle in this state unless the 16 person is restrained by a safety belt.

Any person who violates the provisions of this section 17 (8) commits a nonmoving violation, punishable as provided in chapter 18 318. However, except for violations of s. 316.613 and paragraph 19 (4) (a), enforcement of this section by state or local law 20 21 enforcement agencies must be accomplished only as a secondary action when a driver of a motor vehicle has been detained for a 22 23 suspected violation of another section of this chapter, chapter 320, or chapter 322. 24

25 (9) By January 1, 2006, each law enforcement agency in this state shall adopt departmental policies to prohibit the 26 practice of racial profiling. When a law enforcement officer 27 issues a citation for a violation of this section, the law 28 enforcement officer must record the race and ethnicity of the 29 30 violator. All law enforcement agencies must maintain such information and forward the information to the department in a 31 32 form and manner determined by the department. The department shall collect this information by jurisdiction and annually 33 report the data to the Governor, the President of the Senate, 34 35 and the Speaker of the House of Representatives.
