24 316.2015 Unlawful for person to ride on exterior of 25 vehicle.--

(1) It is unlawful for any operator of a passenger vehicle 26 27 to permit any person to ride on the bumper, radiator, fender, hood, top, trunk, or running board of such vehicle when operated 28 29 upon any street or highway which is maintained by the state, a county, or a municipality. However, the operator of any vehicle 30 shall not be in violation of this section when such operator 31 permits any person to occupy seats securely affixed to the 32 33 exterior of such vehicle. Any person who violates the provisions 34 of this subsection shall be cited for a moving violation, punishable as provided in chapter 318. 35

36 (2)(a) No person shall ride on any vehicle upon any
37 portion thereof not designed or intended for the use of
38 passengers. <u>This paragraph shall not apply to:</u>

39 <u>1. An employee of a fire department or a volunteer</u> 40 <u>firefighter when the firefighter is engaged in the necessary</u> 41 <u>discharge of a duty;</u>

42 <u>2. A person who is being transported in response to an</u> 43 <u>emergency by a public agency or pursuant to the direction or</u> 44 <u>authority of a public agency; or</u>

An employee of a solid waste or recyclable collection service while in the course of employment collecting solid waste or recyclables on designated routes This provision shall not apply to an employee engaged in the necessary discharge of a duty or to a person or persons riding within truck bodies in space intended for merchandise.
