Section 1. Paragraph (c) is added to subsection (2) of section 316.006, Florida Statutes, and paragraph (c) of subsection (3) of said section is amended, to read:

316.006 Jurisdiction.--Jurisdiction to control traffic is vested as follows:

(2) MUNICIPALITIES. --

(c) The governing body of a municipality may exercise its home rule powers granted under chapter 166 to abandon, vacate, discontinue, or close roads or rights-of-way under its jurisdiction pursuant to the terms and conditions specified by the governing body as serving a municipal purpose.

- This subsection shall not limit those counties which have the charter powers to provide and regulate arterial, toll, and other roads, bridges, tunnels, and related facilities from the proper exercise of those powers by the placement and maintenance of traffic control devices which conform to the manual and specifications of the Department of Transportation on streets and highways located within municipal boundaries.
- 37 (3) COUNTIES.--
 - (c) If the governing body of a county abandons the roads and rights-of-way dedicated in a recorded residential subdivision, and simultaneously conveys the county's interest therein to a homeowners' association for the subdivision in the manner prescribed in s. 336.125 316.00825, that county's traffic control jurisdiction over the abandoned and conveyed roads ceases unless the requirements of paragraph (b) are met.

Notwithstanding the provisions of subsection (2), each county shall have original jurisdiction to regulate parking, by resolution of the board of county commissioners and the erection of signs conforming to the manual and specifications of the Department of Transportation, in parking areas located on property owned or leased by the county, whether or not such Page 2 of 3
