15 Section 1. Paragraph (c) of subsection (3) of section
16 316.006, Florida Statutes, is amended to read:

17 316.006 Jurisdiction.--Jurisdiction to control traffic is
18 vested as follows:

19 (3) COUNTIES.--

20 (c) If the governing body of a county abandons the roads
21 and rights-of-way dedicated in a recorded residential
22 subdivision, and simultaneously conveys the county's interest
23 therein to a homeowners' association for the subdivision in the

24 | manner prescribed in s. 336.125 ~~316.00825~~, that county's traffic
 25 | control jurisdiction over the abandoned and conveyed roads
 26 | ceases unless the requirements of paragraph (b) are met.

 28 | Notwithstanding the provisions of subsection (2), each county
 29 | shall have original jurisdiction to regulate parking, by
 30 | resolution of the board of county commissioners and the erection
 31 | of signs conforming to the manual and specifications of the
 32 | Department of Transportation, in parking areas located on
 33 | property owned or leased by the county, whether or not such
 34 | areas are located within the boundaries of chartered
 35 | municipalities.

36 | Section 2. Section 316.00825, Florida Statutes, is
 37 | transferred and renumbered as section 336.125, Florida Statutes.

38 | Section 3. This act shall take effect upon becoming a law.
