- (b) Accept and perform professional responsibilities, including the supervision of any registered nurse or licensed practical nurse, which the physician knows or has reason to know that he or she is not competent to perform.
- nurse or licensed practical nurse when the physician delegating such responsibilities knows or has reason to know that the registered nurse or the licensed practical nurse is not qualified by training, experience, or licensure to perform them.
- Section 2. This act shall take effect July 1, 2005.
