A bill to be entitled

An act relating to alarm system contracting;
amending s. 633.702, F.S.; providing a criminal
penalty for intentionally or willfully
installing, servicing, testing, repairing,
improving, or inspecting a fire alarm system
without being in compliance with s. 489.5185,
F.S., relating to licensure requirements for
fire alarm system agents; providing an
effective date.

Be It Enacted by the Legislature of the State of Florida:

Section 1. Subsection (4) is added to section 633.702,
Florida Statutes, to read:

633.702 Prohibited acts regarding alarm system
contractors or certified unlimited electrical contractors;
penalties.--

(4) It is a misdemeanor of the first degree,
punishable as provided in s. 775.082 or s. 775.083, for any
person to intentionally or willfully install, service, test,
repair, improve, or inspect a fire alarm system without being
in compliance with s. 489.5185.

Section 2. This act shall take effect October 1, 2005.

SENATE SUMMARY

Provides that it is a first-degree misdemeanor to
intentionally or willfully install, service, test,
repair, improve, or inspect a fire alarm system without
being in compliance with the requirements for fire alarm
system agents in s. 489.5185, F.S.
