Senate Amendment

On page 2, lines 13 through 30, delete those lines

and insert:

Section 2. Paragraph (b) of subsection (2) of section 112.19, Florida Statutes, is amended to read:

112.19 Law enforcement, correctional, and correctional probation officers; death benefits.--

(2)

(b) The sum of \$50,000, as adjusted under ~~pursuant to~~ paragraph (j), shall be paid as provided in this section if a law enforcement, correctional, or correctional probation officer is accidentally killed as specified in paragraph (a) and the accidental death occurs:

1. As a result of the officer's response to fresh pursuit;

2. As a result of ~~or to~~ the officer's response to what is reasonably believed to be an emergency;

1 3. At the scene of a traffic accident to which the
2 officer has responded; or

3 4. While the officer is enforcing what is reasonably
4 believed to be a traffic law or ordinance.

6 This sum is in addition to any sum provided for in paragraph
7 (a). Notwithstanding any other provision of law, in no case
8 shall the amount payable under this subsection be less than
9 the actual amount stated therein.
