Senate Amendment (with title amendment)

On page 3, line 12, after the words "account beneficiary."

insert:

(4) Moneys paid into or out of, the assets of, and the income of any hurricane savings account established by an insurance policyholder for residential property in this state to cover an insurance deductible or other uninsured portion of the risks of loss from a hurricane, rising floodwaters, or other catastrophic windstorm event are not liable to attachment, levy, garnishment, or legal process in this state in favor of any creditor of or claimant against any account participant, purchaser, owner or contributor, or account beneficiary. As used in this subsection, the term "hurricane savings account" means an account established by the owner of residential real estate in this state who specifies that the purpose of the account is to cover the amount of insurance
