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The Committee on Health Care (Peaden) recommended the following amendment:

**Senate Amendment (with title amendment)**

On page 2, between lines 10 and 11,

insert:

Section 3. The Department of Health shall implement an educational campaign to inform any person who acquires an automated external defibrillator device that his or her immunity from liability under section 768.1325, Florida Statutes, for harm resulting from the use or attempted use of the device, does not apply if he or she fails to:

(1) Properly maintain and test the device; or

(2) Provide appropriate training in the use of the device to his or her employee or agent when the employee or agent was the person who used the device on the victim, except as provided in section 768.1325, Florida Statutes.

(Redesignate subsequent sections.)
