23 Section 1. Section 4 of chapter 2003-420, Laws of Florida, 24 is amended to read:

25 Section 4. Notwithstanding any other provision of law, the 26 county in which the projects that are part of or ancillary to 27 the state-of-the-art biomedical research institution and campus 28 to be established in this state by the grantee under section 29 288.955, Florida Statutes, are to be located shall have the 30 exclusive right, which right may be assigned in whole or in part by the governing body of the county in its sole discretion, to 31 32 provide water and wastewater services to such projects to the 33 extent deemed necessary by the governing body of the county. The 34 county may plan, acquire, construct, reconstruct, enlarge or 35 extend, operate, and maintain water and wastewater systems and 36 facilities within or without the boundaries of such projects for 37 the provision of water and wastewater services. Provided, the local government or utility service provider shall not be 38 39 authorized to use the provisions of chapter 73 or chapter 74, Florida Statutes, or any other applicable law, to acquire by 40 41 eminent domain the property of any other governmental entity in order to provide water and wastewater service to the biomedical 42 research facility authorized pursuant to s. 288.955, Florida 43 44 Statutes.
