Senate Joint Resolution No. _____

A joint resolution proposing the repeal of
Section 26 of Article X of the State
Constitution, relating to prohibition of
medical license after repeated medical
malpractice.

Be It Resolved by the Legislature of the State of Florida:

That the repeal of Section 26 of Article X of the State
Constitution is agreed to and shall be submitted to the
electors of this state for approval or rejection at the next
general election or at an earlier special election
specifically authorized by law for that purpose.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that the following statement be
placed on the ballot:

CONSTITUTIONAL AMENDMENT
ARTICLE X, SECTION 26

PROHIBITION OF MEDICAL LICENSE AFTER REPEATED MEDICAL
MALPRACTICE.--Proposing the repeal of Section 26 of Article X
of the State Constitution, which section prohibits licensing,
or the continued licensing of, a person as a medical doctor
who has been found to have committed three or more incidents
of medical malpractice.
