The trust fund is exempt from the service 22 charges imposed by s. 215.20. 23 (2) Notwithstanding the provisions of s. 216.301 and 24 pursuant to s. 216.351, any balance in the trust fund at the end 25 of any fiscal year shall remain in the trust fund at the end of 26 the year and shall be available for carrying out the purposes of 27 the trust fund.
