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The Committee on Health Care (Pruitt) recommended the following amendment:

Senate Amendment (with title amendment)

On page 2, between lines 13 and 14,

insert:

(4) A licensed health care practitioner may only administer a vaccine containing more mercury than the maximum level established in subsection (1) or subsection (2) in the case of influenza vaccine, to a knowingly pregnant woman or a child younger than 3 years of age if the practitioner's medical judgment under accepted medical standards is that the benefits of the patient receiving the vaccine to prevent a vaccine-preventable disease outweigh the risks of mercury exposure that could cause or contribute to a life-threatening illness or condition, such as autism. Before administering the vaccine, the practitioner must provide the patient or the patient's legal guardian with information concerning the risks and benefits of the vaccination.
