Section 311.13, Florida Statutes, is 11 12 amended to read: 13 311.13 Certain information exempt from disclosure. -- Seaport security plans of a seaport authority 14 created by act of the Legislature or of a seaport department 15 of a county or municipality that operates an international 16 17 seaport are exempt from provisions of s. 119.07(1) and s. 24(a), Art. I of the State Constitution. In addition, 18 photographs, maps, blueprints, drawings, and similar materials 19 that depict critical seaport operating facilities are exempt 20 from the provisions of s. 119.07(1) and s. 24(a), Art. I of 2.1 22 the State Constitution, to the extent that a seaport authority 23 created by act of the Legislature or a seaport department of a county or municipality that operates a seaport reasonably 2.4 determines that such items contain information that is not 25 generally known and that could jeopardize the security of the 26 27 seaport; however, information relating to real estate leases, 28 layout plans, blueprints, or information relevant thereto, is 29 not to be included in this exemption. The exemptions in this section are applicable only to records held by a seaport 30 authority created by act of the Legislature or to records of a

county or municipal seaport department that operates a seaport. The exemptions contained in this section are subject to the Open Government Sunset Review Act of 1995, in accordance with s. 119.15, and this section shall stand repealed on October 2, 2010 2005, unless reviewed and saved from repeal through reenactment by the Legislature. Section 2. This act shall take effect October 1, 2005. SENATE SUMMARY Extends the exemption from public records disclosure requirements for seaport security plans for an additional 5 years.
