A Class "C" licensee who also holds a Class "D" license, and who has been issued a Class "G" license, may carry a 9 22 millimeter semiautomatic pistol while performing security-23 24 related services. No licensee may carry more than two firearms 25 upon her or his person when performing her or his duties. A 26 licensee may only carry a firearm of the specific type and 27 caliber with which she or he is qualified pursuant to the
