The 21 22 permitting authority granted herein shall be exercised by the 23 municipality within incorporated municipalities and by the 2.4 county outside an incorporated municipality. Before a road on the State Highway System may be temporarily closed for a 25 special event, the local governmental entity which permits the 26 special event to take place must determine that the temporary 27 28 closure of the road is necessary and must obtain the prior written approval for the temporary road closure from the 29 department.
