Senator Geller moved the following amendment:

Senate Amendment (with title amendment)

On page 2, lines 12 and 13, delete those lines

and insert: prior to the approval of the plan.

Section 2. The sum of \$1,862,961 is appropriated from the General Revenue Fund to the Agency for Workforce Innovation for the purpose of funding two positions to implement this act.

Section 3. A professional license issued in the state to a member of the Florida National Guard or the United States Armed Forces Reserves does not expire while the member is serving on federal active duty and may be extended for up to 90 days after the member returns from federal active duty. To qualify for the extension, the member must present to the authority issuing the license a copy of the member's official military orders or a written verification from the member's commanding officer before the end of the 90-day period. A member whose license is renewed during such 90-day period is responsible only for the fees or activities normally related
