Pine Tree Water Control District continuation and transfer.--The Pine Tree Water Control District, an 29 independent special district created by a special act of the 30 31 Legislature, shall become a dependent district of the Village of 32 Wellington on the effective date of this act. All special acts 33 of the Pine Tree Water Control District shall become ordinances 34 of the Village of Wellington on the effective date of this act. 35 The assets, liabilities, and written contracts of the (1)36 Pine Tree Water Control District, including all rights, 37 obligations, duties, and relationships now existing by law or 38 agreement shall be unaffected and shall remain in full force and effect and shall be those of the district as a dependent 39 district of the Village of Wellington.
