**Senate Amendment (with title amendment)**

On page 7, line 25, after the period,

insert: Further, to ensure uniform safety standards for consumer fireworks, the state has exclusive power to regulate the sale, use, safety standards, and possession of fireworks in this state. A county, municipality, or other unit of local government may not enact any ordinance, rule, regulation, or other law after March 8, 2005, which prohibits or interferes with the safety standards established by state law or the right to purchase, sell, use, or possess consumer fireworks in this state.
