**Senate Amendment (with title amendment)**

On page 1, lines 11 and 12, delete those lines

and insert:

Section 1. The Legislature recognizes that certain counties that have large student populations may have difficulties in obtaining suitable land for the establishment of public schools to serve those student populations. The intent of the Legislature is to authorize municipalities in these counties to exercise the power of eminent domain to aid the school districts in these counties in obtaining suitable land to meet the needs of the districts' student population.

Section 2. A municipality located within a county that has a public school student population in grades K-12 of 350,000 or more before December 31, 2006, may exercise
