A municipality may exercise the power of 11 12 eminent domain for the purpose of obtaining lands to be 13 conveyed by the municipality to the school board of the school district within which the municipality is located if the 14 school board of that county requests in writing that the 15 municipality obtain such land for conveyance to the school 16 17 board and promises to use the land to establish a public school thereon. Fulfilling the purpose of this section is 18 recognized as constituting a valid municipal public purpose. 19 This section expires January 1, 2006. Such expiration does 2.0 21 not affect an action in eminent domain which was filed before 22 January 1, 2006. 23 Section 2. This act shall take effect upon becoming a 2.4 law. 25 26 27 SENATE SUMMARY 2.8 Authorizes municipalities to exercise eminent domain for public school purposes. Provides for future expiration of 29 the act. 30 31
