A municipality located within a county, as 11 12 defined in section 125.011(1), Florida Statutes, may exercise 13 the power of eminent domain for the purpose of obtaining lands to be conveyed by the municipality to the school board of the 14 school district within which the municipality is located if 15 the school board of that county requests in writing that the 16 17 municipality obtain such land for conveyance to the school 18 board and promises to use the land to establish a public school thereon. Fulfilling the purpose of this section is 19 recognized as constituting a valid municipal public purpose. 20 21 This section expires January 1, 2007. Such expiration does 22 not affect an action in eminent domain which was filed before 23 January 1, 2007. 2.4 Section 2. This act shall take effect upon becoming a 25 law. 26 27 STATEMENT OF SUBSTANTIAL CHANGES CONTAINED IN COMMITTEE SUBSTITUTE FOR Senate Bill 756 2.8 29 The CS limits the application of the provisions contained in 30 the bill to Miami-Dade County. Additionally, the CS extends the expiration date from January 1, 2006, to January 1, 2007. 31
