The Legislature recognizes that certain 11 12 counties that have large student populations may have 13 difficulties in obtaining suitable land for the establishment of public schools to serve those student populations. The 14 intent of the Legislature is to authorize municipalities in 15 these counties to exercise the power of eminent domain to aid 16 17 the school districts in these counties in obtaining suitable 18 land to meet the needs of the districts' student population. Section 2. A municipality located within a county that 19 has a public school student population in grades K-12 of 2.0 21 350,000 or more before December 31, 2006, may exercise the 2.2 power of eminent domain for the purpose of obtaining lands to 23 be conveyed by the municipality to the school board of the school district within which the municipality is located if 2.4 the school board of that county requests in writing that the 25 26 municipality obtain such land for conveyance to the school 27 board and promises to use the land to establish a public 2.8 school thereon. Fulfilling the purpose of this section is recognized as constituting a valid municipal public purpose. 29 This section expires January 1, 2007. Such expiration does 30 31
