Section 1. This act may be cited as the "Justin McWilliams 'Justice For Justin' Act."

Section 2. Subsection (1) of section 316.027, Florida Statutes, is amended to read:

316.027 Crash involving death or personal injuries.--

(1)(a) The driver of any vehicle involved in a crash occurring on public or private property that results resulting in injury of any person must immediately stop the vehicle at the scene of the crash, or as close thereto as possible, and must
