29 Point du Sable Boulevard in Miami-Dade County;
30 designating Eric Ulysses Ramirez Highway in
31 Lake County; designating Trooper Darryl Haywood

1 Highway, David Hinson and Charles W. Cherry in
2 Volusia County; designating Teye Brown Parkway,
3 Charles B. Dailey Parkway, and Johnnie Mae
4 Chappell Parkway in Duval County; designating
5 Dr. John M. Haile Memorial Boulevard in Marion
6 County; designating Bob Graham/Sunshine Skyway
7 Bridge in Pinellas County; and designating
8 Ricardo Karakadze Street in Miami-Dade County;
9 directing the Department of Transportation to

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13 Be It Enacted by the Legislature of the State of Florida:

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15 Section 1. Ramon Puig Way designated; Department of
16 Transportation to erect suitable markers.--

17 (1) That portion of S.W. 8th Street between S.W. 62nd
18 Avenue and S.W. 67th Avenue in Miami-Dade County is designated
19 as "Ramon Puig Way."

20 (2) The Department of Transportation is directed to
21 erect suitable markers designating Ramon Puig Way as described
22 in subsection (1).

23 Section 2. Shawn O'Dare Way designated; Department of
24 Transportation to erect suitable markers.--

25 (1) That portion of N.W. 167th Street between N.W.
26 57th Avenue and N.W. 67th Avenue in the Town of Miami Lakes in
27 Miami-Dade County is designated as "Shawn O'Dare Way."

28 (2) The Department of Transportation is directed to
29 erect suitable markers designating Shawn O'Dare Way as
30 described in subsection (1).

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1 Section 3. Marge Pearlson Way designated; Department
2 of Transportation to erect suitable markers.--

3 (1) That portion of S.W. 129th Terrace between East
4 67th Avenue and 64th Avenue in Miami-Dade County is designated
5 as "Marge Pearlson Way."

6 (2) The Department of Transportation is directed to
7 erect suitable markers designating Marge Pearlson Way as
8 described in subsection (1).

9 Section 4. Jorge L. Cabrera Way designated; Department
10 of Transportation to erect suitable markers.--

11 (1) That portion of Coral Way, S.W. 24th Street,
12 between 107th Avenue and 109th Avenue in Miami-Dade County is
13 designated as "Jorge L. Cabrera Way."

14 (2) The Department of Transportation is directed to
15 erect suitable markers designating Jorge L. Cabrera Way as
16 described in subsection (1).

17 Section 5. Correction Officers Memorial Bridge
18 designated; Department of Transportation to erect suitable
19 markers.--

20 (1) The New River Bridge on State Road 16 in Bradford
21 and Union Counties is designated as "Correction Officers
22 Memorial Bridge."

23 (2) The Department of Transportation is directed to
24 erect suitable markers designating Correction Officers
25 Memorial Bridge as described in subsection (1).

26 Section 6. Martin Andersen Beachline Expressway
27 designated; Department of Transportation to erect suitable
28 markers.--

29 (1) That portion of State Road 528 between its western
30 terminus in Orange County and its eastern terminus in Brevard
31 County, excluding that portion between U.S. Route 1 and State

1 Road 3, is designated as "Martin Andersen Beachline
2 Expressway."

3 (2) The Department of Transportation is directed to
4 erect suitable markers designating Martin Andersen Beachline
5 Expressway as described in subsection (1).

6 (3) This section has no effect on chapter 98-423, Laws
7 of Florida, which designated that portion of State Road 528
8 between State Road 436 and State Road A1A as "Kennedy Space
9 Center Highway," and, therefore, the section of State Road 528
10 east of State Road 15 shall continue to have two names.

11 (4) That portion of State Road 528 between U.S. Route
12 1 and State Road 3 has been designated as "Emory Bennett
13 Causeway" and shall continue to have that designation
14 notwithstanding this section.

15 Section 7. Daniel Webster Western Beltway designated;
16 Department of Transportation to erect suitable markers.--

17 (1) That portion of State Road 429 between Interstate
18 4 and U.S. Highway 441 in Orange County is designated as
19 "Daniel Webster Western Beltway."

20 (2) The Department of Transportation is directed to
21 erect suitable markers designating Daniel Webster Western
22 Beltway as described in subsection (1).

23 Section 8. Robert F. Grim, Sr., Memorial Parkway
24 designated; Department of Transportation to erect suitable
25 markers.--

26 (1) That portion of Nova Road between Granada
27 Boulevard and U.S. Highway 1 in Volusia County is designated
28 as "Robert F. Grim, Sr., Memorial Parkway."

29 (2) The Department of Transportation is directed to
30 erect 106 suitable markers designating Robert F. Grim, Sr.,
31 Memorial Parkway as described in subsection (1).

1 Section 9. Veteran's Memorial Boulevard designated;
2 Department of Transportation to erect suitable markers.--

3 (1) That portion of U.S. Highway 331 from its
4 intersection with U.S. Highway 90 South to the southern border
5 of the City of DeFuniak Springs in Walton County is designated
6 as "Veteran's Memorial Boulevard."

7 (2) The Department of Transportation is directed to
8 erect suitable markers designating Veteran's Memorial
9 Boulevard as described in subsection (1).

10 Section 10. Southeastern Guide Dog Overpass
11 designated; Department of Transportation to erect suitable
12 markers.--

13 (1) The overpass on 77th Avenue East, Bridge Number
14 130090, over Interstate 275 in Manatee County is designated as
15 "Southeastern Guide Dog Overpass."

16 (2) The Department of Transportation is directed to
17 erect suitable markers designating Southeastern Guide Dog
18 Overpass as described in subsection (1).

19 Section 11. Joseph O. Striska Florida Welcome Center
20 designated; Department of Transportation to erect suitable
21 markers.--

22 (1) The Florida Welcome Center on Interstate 75 at the
23 Georgia state line in Hamilton County is designated as Joseph
24 O. Striska Florida Welcome Center."

25 (2) The Department of Transportation is directed to
26 erect suitable markers designating Joseph O. Striska Florida
27 Welcome Center as described in subsection (1).

28 Section 12. Purple Heart Memorial Highway designated;
29 Department of Transportation to erect suitable markers.--

1 (1) That portion of U.S. Highway 27 that lies within
2 Highlands County is designated as "Purple Heart Memorial
3 Highway."

4 (2) The Department of Transportation is directed to
5 erect suitable markers designating Purple Heart Memorial
6 Highway as described in subsection (1).

7 Section 13. Section 25 of chapter 2004-392, Laws of
8 Florida, is repealed.

9 Section 14. St. Petersburg Parkway/William C. Cramer
10 Memorial Highway designated; Department of Transportation to
11 erect suitable markers.--

12 (1) That portion of Interstate 275 in Pinellas County
13 that extends from the Howard Frankland Bridge to the Sunshine
14 Skyway Bridge is designated as "St. Petersburg Parkway/William
15 C. Cramer Memorial Highway."

16 (2) The Department of Transportation is directed to
17 erect suitable markers designating St. Petersburg
18 Parkway/William C. Cramer Memorial Highway as described in
19 subsection (1).

20 Section 15. Richard E. "Pete" Damon Bridge designated;
21 Department of Transportation to erect suitable markers.--

22 (1) The bridge over the Loxahatchee River on State
23 Road Alternate A1A in the Town of Jupiter in Palm Beach County
24 is designated as "Richard E. 'Pete' Damon Bridge."

25 (2) The Department of Transportation is directed to
26 erect suitable markers designating Richard E. "Pete" Damon
27 Bridge as described in subsection (1).

28 Section 16. Alexander Alden Ware Memorial Cable
29 Barrier System designated; Department of Transportation to
30 erect suitable markers.--

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1 (1) The cable barrier system along the Florida
2 Turnpike in Palm Beach, St. Lucie, and Miami-Dade Counties is
3 designated as "Alexander Alden Ware Memorial Cable Barrier
4 System."

5 (2) The Department of Transportation is directed to
6 erect suitable markers designating Alexander Alden Ware
7 Memorial Cable Barrier System as described in subsection (1).

8 Section 17. Roi Henri Christophe Boulevard designated;
9 Department of Transportation to erect suitable markers.--

10 (1) That portion of State Road 916 on N.W. 135th
11 Street between N.W. 7th Avenue and N.E. 6th Avenue in
12 Miami-Dade County is designated as "Roi Henri Christophe
13 Boulevard."

14 (2) The Department of Transportation is directed to
15 erect suitable markers designating Roi Henri Christophe
16 Boulevard as described in subsection (1).

17 Section 18. Charles Summer Boulevard designated;
18 Department of Transportation to erect suitable markers.--

19 (1) That portion of State Road 916 on N.W. 135th
20 Street between N.W. 17th Avenue and N.W. 7th Avenue in
21 Miami-Dade County is designated as "Charles Summer Boulevard."

22 (2) The Department of Transportation is directed to
23 erect suitable markers designating Charles Summer Boulevard as
24 described in subsection (1).

25 Section 19. Capois-La-Mort Boulevard designated;
26 Department of Transportation to erect suitable markers.--

27 (1) That portion of State Road 916 on N.E. 135th
28 Street between N.E. 6th Avenue and Biscayne Boulevard in
29 Miami-Dade County is designated as "Capois-La-Mort Boulevard."

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1 (2) The Department of Transportation is directed to
2 erect suitable markers designating Capois-La-Mort Boulevard as
3 described in subsection (1).

4 Section 20. Jean Baptiste Point du Sable Boulevard
5 designated; Department of Transportation to erect suitable
6 markers.--

7 (1) That portion of State Road 934 on N.W. 79th Street
8 between Interstate 95 and N.E. 10th Avenue in Miami-Dade
9 County is designated as "Jean Baptiste Point du Sable
10 Boulevard."

11 (2) The Department of Transportation is directed to
12 erect suitable markers designating Jean Baptiste Point du
13 Sable Boulevard as described in subsection (1).

14 Section 21. Eric Ulysses Ramirez Highway designated;
15 Department of Transportation to erect suitable markers.--

16 (1) The portion of State Road 50 in Lake County
17 between the community of Stuckey and the Mascotte city limits
18 is designated as the "Eric Ulysses Ramirez Highway."

19 (2) The Department of Transportation is directed to
20 erect suitable markers designating the Eric Ulysses Ramirez
21 Highway as described in subsection (1).

22 Section 22. Trooper Darryl Haywood Highway designated;
23 Department of Transportation to erect suitable markers.--

24 (1) That portion of Interstate Highway 4 in the
25 vicinity of mile marker 123 in Volusia County is designated as
26 "Trooper Darryl Haywood Highway."

27 (2) The Department of Transportation is directed to
28 erect suitable markers designating Trooper Darryl Haywood
29 Highway as described in subsection (1).

30 Section 23. David Hinson Parkway designated.
31 Department of Transportation to erect suitable markers.--

1 (1) That portion of Nova Road in Volusia County
2 between International Speedway Boulevard to George W. Ingram
3 Boulevard is designated as the "David Hinson Parkway."

4 (2) The Department of Transportation is directed to
5 erect suitable markers designating the David Hinson Parkway as
6 described in subsection (1).

7 Section 24. Charles W. Cherry, Sr., Parkway
8 designated; Department of Transportation to erect suitable
9 markers.--

10 (1) That portion of International Speedway Boulevard
11 between Nova Road and Beach Street in Volusia County is
12 designated as "Charles W. Cherry, Sr., Parkway."

13 (2) The Department of Transportation is directed to
14 erect suitable markers designating Charles W. Cherry, Sr.,
15 Parkway as described in subsection (1).

16 Section 25. Taye Brown Parkway designated; Department
17 of Transportation to erect suitable markers.--

18 (1) That portion of New Kings Road (U.S. 1) in Duval
19 County between the 2400 block and the 3700 block is designated
20 as "Taye Brown Parkway."

21 (2) The Department of Transportation is directed to
22 erect suitable markers designating Taye Brown Parkway as
23 described in subsection (1).

24 Section 26. Charles B. Dailey Parkway designated;
25 Department of Transportation to erect suitable markers.--

26 (1) That portion of the Haines Street Expressway
27 between Jessie Street and Eighth Street in Duval County is
28 designated as "Charles B. Dailey Parkway."

29 (2) The Department of Transportation is directed to
30 erect suitable markers designating Charles B. Dailey Parkway
31 as described in subsection (1).

1 Section 27. Johnnie Mae Chappell Parkway designated;
2 Department of Transportation to erect suitable markers.--

3 (1) That portion of U.S. Highway 1 between Finch
4 Avenue and Redpoll Avenue in Duval County is designated as
5 "Johnnie Mae Chappell Parkway."

6 (2) The Department of Transportation is directed to
7 erect suitable markers designating Johnnie Mae Chappell
8 Parkway as described in subsection (1).

9 Section 28. Dr. John M. Haile Memorial Boulevard
10 designated; Department of Transportation to erect suitable
11 markers.--

12 (1) That portion of East Silver Springs Boulevard,
13 State Road 40, in the City of Ocala from East 11th Avenue to
14 East 16th Avenue is designated as the "Dr. John M. Haile
15 Memorial Boulevard."

16 (2) The Department of Transportation is directed to
17 erect suitable markers designating the Dr. John M. Haile
18 Memorial Boulevard, as directed in subsection (1).

19 Section 29. Bob Graham/Sunshine Skyway Bridge
20 designated; Department of Transportation to erect suitable
21 markers.--

22 (1) The Sunshine Skyway Bridge over Tampa Bay is
23 designated as the "Bob Graham/Sunshine Skyway Bridge."

24 (2) The Department of Transportation is directed to
25 erect suitable markers designating the Bob Graham/Sunshine
26 Skyway Bridge as described in subsection (1).

27 Section 30. Ricardo Karakadze Street designated;
28 Department of Transportation to erect suitable markers.--

29 (1) The portion of 104th Street between U.S. 1 and
30 97th Avenue is designated as the "Ricardo Karakadze Street."

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1 (2) The Department of Transportation is directed to
2 erect suitable markers designating the Ricardo Karakadze
3 Street as described in subsection (1).

4 Section 31. This act shall take effect July 1, 2005.
