However, only a veterinarian may immunize or treat an animal for diseases which 26 27 are communicable to humans and which are of public health 28 significance. 29 30 For the purposes of chapters 465 and 893, persons exempt pursuant to subsection (1), subsection (2), or subsection (4) 31 are deemed to be duly licensed practitioners authorized by the 32 33 laws of this state to prescribe drugs or medicinal supplies. 34 Section 2. This act shall take effect upon becoming a law.
