An act relating to an exemption from the tax on sales, use, and other transactions for solar energy systems; amending s. 212.08, F.S.; deleting a scheduled repeal of such exemption; providing an effective date.

Be It Enacted by the Legislature of the State of Florida:

9 Section 1. Paragraph (hh) of subsection (7) of section
10 212.08, Florida Statutes, is amended to read:

11 212.08 Sales, rental, use, consumption, distribution, and 12 storage tax; specified exemptions.--The sale at retail, the 13 rental, the use, the consumption, the distribution, and the 14 storage to be used or consumed in this state of the following 15 are hereby specifically exempt from the tax imposed by this 16 chapter.

17 MISCELLANEOUS EXEMPTIONS .-- Exemptions provided to any (7)18 entity by this chapter do not inure to any transaction that is 19 otherwise taxable under this chapter when payment is made by a representative or employee of the entity by any means, 20 including, but not limited to, cash, check, or credit card, even 21 when that representative or employee is subsequently reimbursed 22 by the entity. In addition, exemptions provided to any entity by 23 24 this subsection do not inure to any transaction that is 25 otherwise taxable under this chapter unless the entity has obtained a sales tax exemption certificate from the department 26 27 or the entity obtains or provides other documentation as required by the department. Eligible purchases or leases made 28 29 with such a certificate must be in strict compliance with this Page 1 of 2

30 subsection and departmental rules, and any person who makes an 31 exempt purchase with a certificate that is not in strict 32 compliance with this subsection and the rules is liable for and 33 shall pay the tax. The department may adopt rules to administer 34 this subsection.

(hh) Solar energy systems.--Also exempt are solar energy systems or any component thereof. The Florida Solar Energy Center shall from time to time certify to the department a list of equipment and requisite hardware considered to be a solar energy system or a component thereof. This exemption is repealed July 1, 2005.
