23	additional retirement credit to upgrade such service to
24	Special Risk Class service, to the extent of the percentages

the date of payment. Such purchased service credits shall, for purposes of s. 121.091, apply toward satisfaction of the special risk normal retirement date, as defined in s. 121.021(29)(b). This service credit may be purchased by the employer on behalf of the member. б Section 2. This act shall take effect upon becoming a law. SENATE SUMMARY Allows a person who has retirement credit for service as a community-based correctional probation officer, which service is not in the Special Risk Class of the Florida Retirement System, to purchase additional credit to upgrade it to Special Risk Class service. Such upgrade may also be purchased on the employee's behalf by his or her employer. 2.4
