Section 288.833, Florida Statutes, is created 15 to read: 16 288.833 State Homeland Security Trust Fund.--17 There is created the State Homeland Security Trust (1) 18 Fund, to be administered by the Division of Emergency Management 19 within the Department of Community Affairs. Funds shall be 20 credited to the trust fund as provided in s. 288.857(4)(c), to 21 be used to fund state homeland security with priorities for 22 funding to focus on costs not funded by the Federal Government, such as operational costs of security at seaports and other 23 24 venues. Requests for funding shall be reviewed by the Domestic 25 Security Oversight Board which shall provide recommended funding 26 priorities. 27 (2) Notwithstanding the provisions of s. 216.301 and pursuant to s. 216.351, any balance in the trust fund at the end 28 29 of any fiscal year shall remain in the trust fund at the end of
