HB 857 2005 A bill to be entitled

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An act relating to the Pal-Mar Water Control District, Palm Beach and Martin Counties; codifying, amending, reenacting, and repealing special acts relating to the district; providing boundaries; providing for a board of supervisors; providing membership, terms of office, removal from office, and powers of the board; repealing chapters 82-356 and 85-483, Laws of Florida; providing for severability; providing an effective date.

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Be It Enacted by the Legislature of the State of Florida:

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Section 1. Pursuant to section 189.429(1), Florida Statutes, this act constitutes the codification of all special acts relating to the Pal-Mar Water Control District. It is the intent of the Legislature in enacting this law to provide a single, comprehensive special act charter for the district, including all current legislative authority granted to the district by its prior legislative enactments and any additional authority granted by this act. It is further the intent of this act to preserve all district powers and authority as set forth herein.

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Section 2. Chapters 82-356 and 85-483, Laws of Florida, are codified, reenacted, amended, and repealed as herein provided.

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The Pal-Mar Water Control District is re-Section 3. created and the charter for such district is re-created and reenacted to read:

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Section 1. District created and boundaries thereof. -- That

30 for the purpose of reclaiming and protecting the lands 31 hereinafter described from the effects of water by drainage or otherwise, for sanitary and agricultural purposes, to be 32 conducive to the public health, convenience, and welfare of 33 34 public utility and benefit, and that such purposes will be 35 effected by the drainage of said lands, and for other purposes 36 stated in this act, a district is hereby created and established 37 in Palm Beach and Martin Counties, to be known as Pal-Mar Water Control District, the territorial boundaries of which are as 38

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to the Northeast corner of said Section 21; thence run Northerly along the West line of Section 15, Township 40 South, Range 40 East, to an intersection with the Old Jupiter Grade; thence meander Southeasterly along the Old Jupiter Grade to an intersection with the South line of said Section 15; thence run Easterly along said South line to the South Quarter Corner of said Section 15; thence run Northerly along the West line of the East one-half (E½) of said Section 15 to the North line of said Section 15; thence run Northerly along the West line of the East one-half (E½) of Section 10, Township 40 South, Range 40 East, to the North line of said Section 10; thence run Easterly along said North line to the Northeast corner of said Section 10; thence run Easterly along the North line of Section 11, Township 40 South, Range 40 East, to the Northeast corner of said Section 11; thence run Easterly along the North line of Section 12, Township 40 South, Range 40 East, to the Northeast corner of said Section 12; thence run Southerly along the East line of said Section 12 to the Southeast corner of said Section 12; thence run Easterly along the North line of Section 18, Township 40 South, Range 41 East, to the Northeast corner; thence run Southerly along the East line of said Section 18 to the Southeast corner of said Section 18; thence run Easterly along the North line of Section 20, Township 40 South, Range 41 East, to the Northeast corner of said Section 20; thence run Southerly along the East

Section 2. Board of supervisors. --

- (1) The Board of Supervisors of the Pal-Mar Water Control District shall have five supervisors selected as follows:
- (a) One supervisor shall be either a member of the Board of County Commissioners of Palm Beach County or a landowner within the district appointed by the Board of County Commissioners of Palm Beach County.
- (b) One supervisor shall be either a member of the Board of County Commissioners of Martin County or a landowner within the district appointed by the Board of County Commissioners of Martin County.
- (c) Three supervisors shall be selected by the landowners in accordance with section 298.11, Florida Statutes.
- (2) The appointed supervisors of the Pal-Mar Water Control District shall serve 1-year terms of office beginning the second Wednesday in June of each year or until such time as a successor has been selected.
- (3) Any supervisor appointed by the Board of County

 Commissioners of Palm Beach County or the Board of County

 Commissioners of Martin County may be removed by the appointing

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204 board for dishonesty, incompetency, or failure to perform the duties imposed on that supervisor by chapter 298, Florida Statutes.

Section 3. Powers of board of supervisors.--

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- (1) The Board of Supervisors of the Pal-Mar Water Control District in Palm Beach and Martin Counties is hereby authorized to plan, construct, and maintain different water control systems by units of development within the district, with different assessment areas according to the benefits received, so as to most equitably provide for assessments according to benefits, based upon the plans and recommendations of the chief engineer for the district.
- (2) The board of supervisors is hereby prohibited from planning, constructing, and maintaining different water control systems by units of development within the district unless the owners of a majority of the acres within the unit to be developed express their desire, in writing or by referendum or by certified letter, to have the water control system developed.
- Section 4. Chapters 82-356 and 85-483, Laws of Florida, are repealed.

Section 5. In case any one or more of the sections or provisions of this act or the application of such sections or provisions to any situation, circumstances, or person shall for any reason be held to be unconstitutional, such unconstitutionality shall not affect any other sections or provisions of this act or the application of such sections or provisions to any other situation, circumstance, or person, and it is intended that this act shall be construed and applied as if such section or provision had not been included herein for

233 any unconstitutional application.

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Section 6. This act shall take effect upon becoming a law.

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
