1 The Local Government Council recommends the following: 2 3 Council/Committee Substitute 4 Remove the entire bill and insert: 5 A bill to be entitled 6 An act relating to the Pal-Mar Water Control District, 7 Palm Beach and Martin Counties; codifying, amending, 8 reenacting, and repealing special acts relating to the 9 district; providing boundaries; providing for a board of 10 supervisors; providing membership, terms of office, 11 removal from office, and powers of the board; repealing 12 chapters 82-356 and 85-483, Laws of Florida; providing for severability; providing an effective date. 13 14 15 Be It Enacted by the Legislature of the State of Florida: 16 17 Section 1. Pursuant to section 189.429(1), Florida 18 Statutes, this act constitutes the codification of all special 19 acts relating to the Pal-Mar Water Control District. It is the 20 intent of the Legislature in enacting this law to provide a 21 single, comprehensive special act charter for the district, 22 including all current legislative authority granted to the 23 district by its prior legislative enactments and any additional Page 1 of 9

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24	authority granted by this act. It is further the intent of this
25	act to preserve all district powers and authority as set forth
26	herein.
27	Section 2. Chapters 82-356 and 85-483, Laws of Florida,
28	are codified, reenacted, amended, and repealed as herein
29	provided.
30	Section 3. The Pal-Mar Water Control District is re-
31	created and the charter for such district is re-created and
32	reenacted to read:
33	Section 1. District created and boundaries thereofThat
34	for the purpose of reclaiming and protecting the lands
35	hereinafter described from the effects of water by drainage or
36	otherwise, for sanitary and agricultural purposes, to be
37	conducive to the public health, convenience, and welfare of
38	public utility and benefit, and that such purposes will be
39	effected by the drainage of said lands, and for other purposes
40	stated in this act, a district is hereby created and established
41	in Palm Beach and Martin Counties, to be known as Pal-Mar Water
42	Control District, an independent special district, the
43	territorial boundaries of which are as follows:

45	Begin at the point of intersection of the East line of
46	Section 32, Township 40 South, Range 41 East and the
47	North right of way line of State Road 706; thence run
48	Westerly along said right of way line to the
49	intersection of said North right of way line of State
50	Road 706 with the North right of way line of State
51	Road 710 (Bee Line Highway); thence run Northwesterly

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52	along said North right of way line of said State Road
53	710 to the intersection of said right of way line with
54	the West line of the East one-half (E½) of Section 23,
55	Township 40 South, Range 39 East; thence run Northerly
56	along said West line of the East one-half (E½) to the
57	Northerly line of said Section 23; thence run
58	Northerly along the West line of the East one-half
59	(E½) of Section 14, Township 40 South, Range 39 East,
60	to the Northerly line of said Section 14; thence run
61	Northerly along the West line of the East one-half
62	(E½) of Section 11, Township 40 South, Range 39 East,
63	to the Northerly line of Section 11, thence run
64	Northerly along the West line of the East one-half
65	(E½) of Section 2, Township 40 South, Range 39 East to
66	the South right of way line of State Road 76; thence
67	run Northeasterly along said South right of way line
68	of said State Road 76 to the intersection with the
69	East line of the West one-half ($W\frac{1}{2}$) of Section 36,
70	Township 39 South, Range 39 East; thence run Southerly
71	along said East line of the West one-half (W $\frac{1}{2}$) of said
72	Section 36 to the North line of Section 1, Township 40
73	South, Range 39 East; thence run South along the East
74	line of the West one-half (W $\frac{1}{2}$) of said Section 1,
75	Township 40 South, Range 39 East to the North line of
76	Section 12, Township 40 South, Range 39 East; thence
77	run Southerly along the East line of the West one-half
78	(W½) of said Section 12 to the North line of Section
79	13, Township 40 South, Range 39 East; thence run
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80	Easterly along said North line to the Northeast corner
81	of said Section 13; thence run Southerly along the
82	East line of said Section 13 to an intersection with
83	the Old Jupiter Grade; thence meander said Old Jupiter
84	Grade Southeasterly through Section 18, Township 40
85	South, Range 40 East, to the East line of said Section
86	18; thence run Southerly along said East line to the
87	Southeast corner of said Section 18; thence run
88	Easterly along the North line of Section 20, Township
89	40 South, Range 40 East, to the Northeast corner of
90	said Section 20; thence run Easterly along the North
91	line of Section 21, Township 40 South, Range 40 East,
92	to the Northeast corner of said Section 21; thence run
93	Northerly along the West line of Section 15, Township
94	40 South, Range 40 East, to an intersection with the
95	Old Jupiter Grade; thence meander Southeasterly along
96	the Old Jupiter Grade to an intersection with the
97	South line of said Section 15; thence run Easterly
98	along said South line to the South Quarter Corner of
99	said Section 15; thence run Northerly along the West
100	line of the East one-half (E½) of said Section 15 to
101	the North line of said Section 15; thence run
102	Northerly along the West line of the East one-half
103	(E ¹ / ₂) of Section 10, Township 40 South, Range 40 East,
104	to the North line of said Section 10; thence run
105	Easterly along said North line to the Northeast corner
106	of said Section 10; thence run Easterly along the
107	North line of Section 11, Township 40 South, Range 40
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108	East, to the Northeast corner of said Section 11;
109	thence run Easterly along the North line of Section
110	12, Township 40 South, Range 40 East, to the Northeast
111	corner of said Section 12; thence run Southerly along
112	the East line of said Section 12 to the Southeast
113	corner of said Section 12; thence run Easterly along
114	the North line of Section 18, Township 40 South, Range
115	41 East, to the Northeast corner; thence run Southerly
116	along the East line of said Section 18 to the
117	Southeast corner of said Section 18; thence run
118	Easterly along the North line of Section 20, Township
119	40 South, Range 41 East, to the Northeast corner of
120	said Section 20; thence run Southerly along the East
121	line of said Section 20 to the Southeast corner of
122	said Section 20; thence run Southerly along the East
123	line of Section 29, Township 40 South, Range 41 East,
124	to the Southeast corner of said Section 29; thence run
125	Southerly along the East line of Section 32, Township
126	40 South, Range 41 East, to the Point of Beginning.

128	the foregoing boundaries containing and including the following
129	lands, to-wit:

131	All that portion of the Southeast Quarter of Section
132	35 lying South of State Road 76 and all of that
133	portion of the Southwest Quarter of Section 36, lying

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136	Range 39 East; that portion of the East Half of	
137	Section 2 lying South of State Road 76, Township 40	
138	South, Range 39 East; the East Half of Section 11, the

188	Section 2. Board of supervisors	
189	(1) The Board of Supervisors of the Pal-Mar Water Control	<u>1</u>
190	District shall have five supervisors selected as follows:	

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CS 191 (a) One supervisor shall be either a member of the Board of County Commissioners of Palm Beach County or a landowner 192 193 within the district appointed by the Board of County 194 Commissioners of Palm Beach County. 195 (b) One supervisor shall be either a member of the Board 196 of County Commissioners of Martin County or a landowner within 197 the district appointed by the Board of County Commissioners of 198 Martin County. 199 (c) Three supervisors shall be selected by the landowners 200 in accordance with section 298.11, Florida Statutes. 201 The appointed supervisors of the Pal-Mar Water Control (2) 202 District shall serve 1-year terms of office beginning the second 203 Wednesday in June of each year or until such time as a successor 204 has been selected. 205 (3) Any supervisor appointed by the Board of County 206 Commissioners of Palm Beach County or the Board of County 207 Commissioners of Martin County may be removed by the appointing 208 board for dishonesty, incompetency, or failure to perform the 209 duties imposed on that supervisor by chapter 298, Florida 210 Statutes. 211 Section 3. Powers of board of supervisors. --212 (1) The Board of Supervisors of the Pal-Mar Water Control 213 District in Palm Beach and Martin Counties is hereby authorized 214 to plan, construct, and maintain different water control systems 215 by units of development within the district, with different 216 assessment areas according to the benefits received, so as to 217 most equitably provide for assessments according to benefits,

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218	based upon the plans and recommendations of the chief engineer
219	for the district.
220	(2) The board of supervisors is hereby prohibited from
221	planning, constructing, and maintaining different water control
222	systems by units of development within the district unless the
223	owners of a majority of the acres within the unit to be
224	developed express their desire, in writing or by referendum or
225	by certified letter, to have the water control system developed.
226	Section 4. Chapters 82-356 and 85-483, Laws of Florida,
227	are repealed.
228	Section 5. In case any one or more of the sections or
229	provisions of this act or the application of such sections or
230	provisions to any situation, circumstances, or person shall for
231	any reason be held to be unconstitutional, such
232	unconstitutionality shall not affect any other sections or
233	provisions of this act or the application of such sections or
234	provisions to any other situation, circumstance, or person, and
235	it is intended that this act shall be construed and applied as
236	if such section or provision had not been included herein for
237	any unconstitutional application.
238	Section 6. This act shall take effect upon becoming a law.

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
