Section 1. Section 491.016, Florida Statutes, is created
to read:
491.016 Professional social work identification
(1) It shall be a misdemeanor of the first degree,
punishable as provided in s. 775.082 or s. 775.083, for a
person, for or without compensation, to hold himself or herself
out to the public as a social worker either directly or through
a governmental or private organization, entity, or agency unless
that person:
1. Possesses at least a bachelor's or master's degree in
social work from a social work program accredited by or from an
institution that is an active candidate for accreditation as a
social work program by the Council of Social Work Education; or
2. Completes, at a university or college outside the
United States or Canada, a social work program determined by the
Foreign Equivalency Determination Service of the Council on
