WHEREAS, at that time, NBC did not offer a full day of programs, leaving Channel 8 to fill time slots with imaginative local programming, including the production of commercials, and

WHEREAS, throughout its 50-year history, Channel 8 has been owned by Media General and has been affiliated with NBC, NOW, THEREFORE,
