WHEREAS, the East Gadsden High School JROTC Color Guard, in keeping with its "win or place" record in every competition during this school term, made Gadsden County history when it placed third among 33 other outstanding high school and military academy drill teams from throughout the Eastern Region of the United States, and

WHEREAS, trained by and under the direction of Master Sergeant Jerome A. Kerrison, Sergeant First Class Michael Williams, and Demetri Webb, the East Gadsden County High School JROTC has compiled a record that marks 2004-2005 as the first year the Male Color Guard has either placed or won in every meet in which it has participated, including state and Cadet Command
